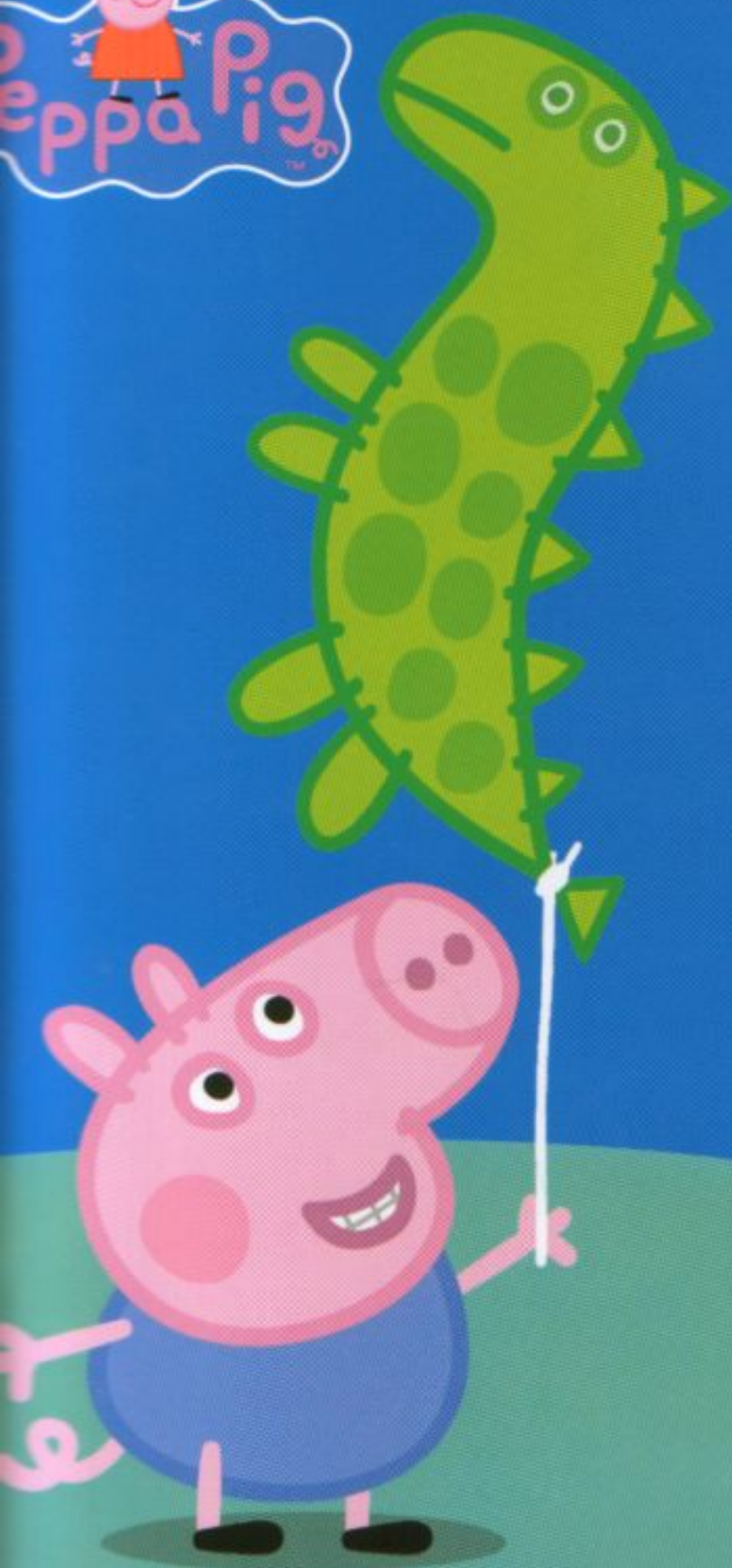




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George's Balloon

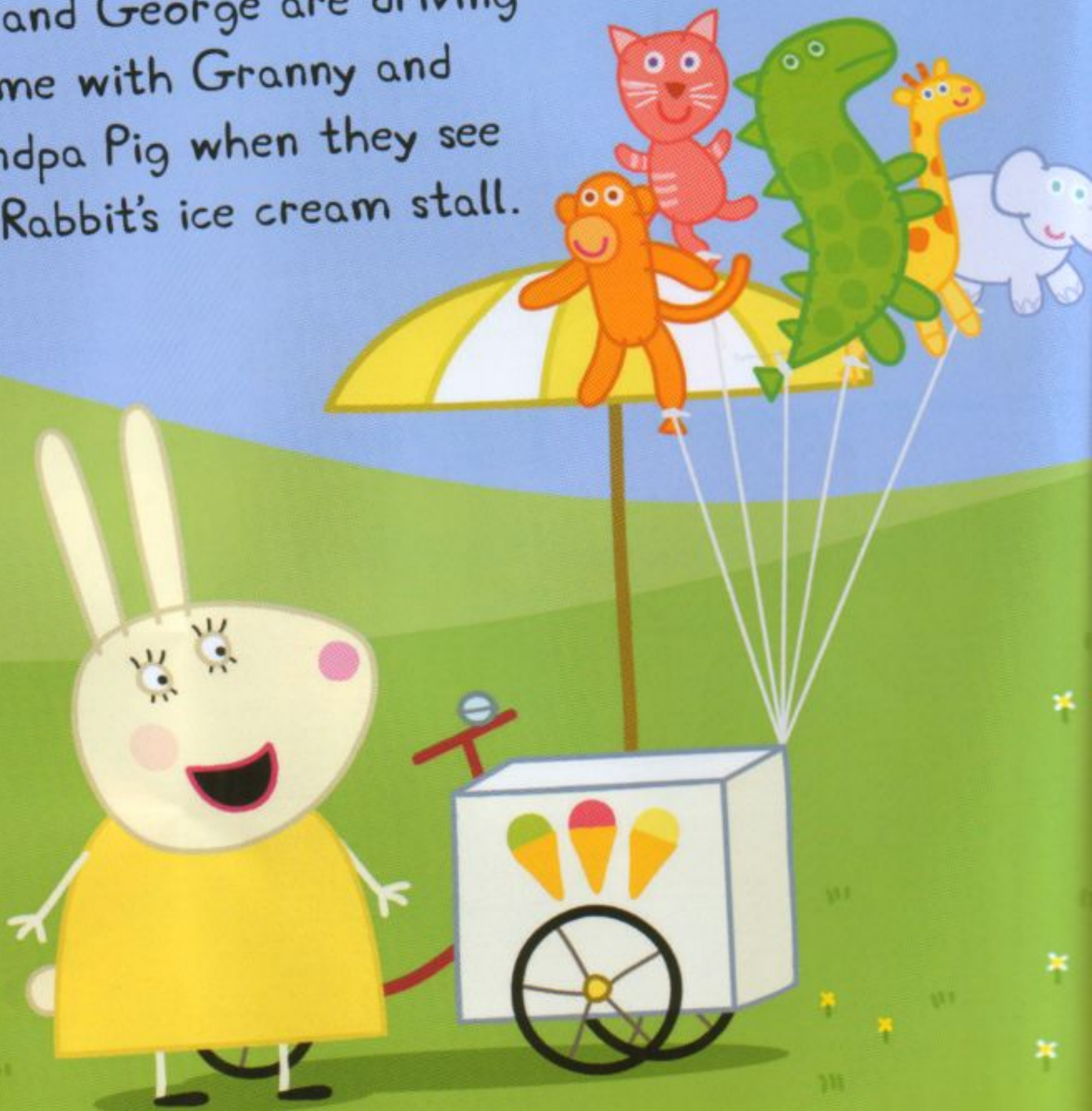




George's Balloon

says Granny Pig.

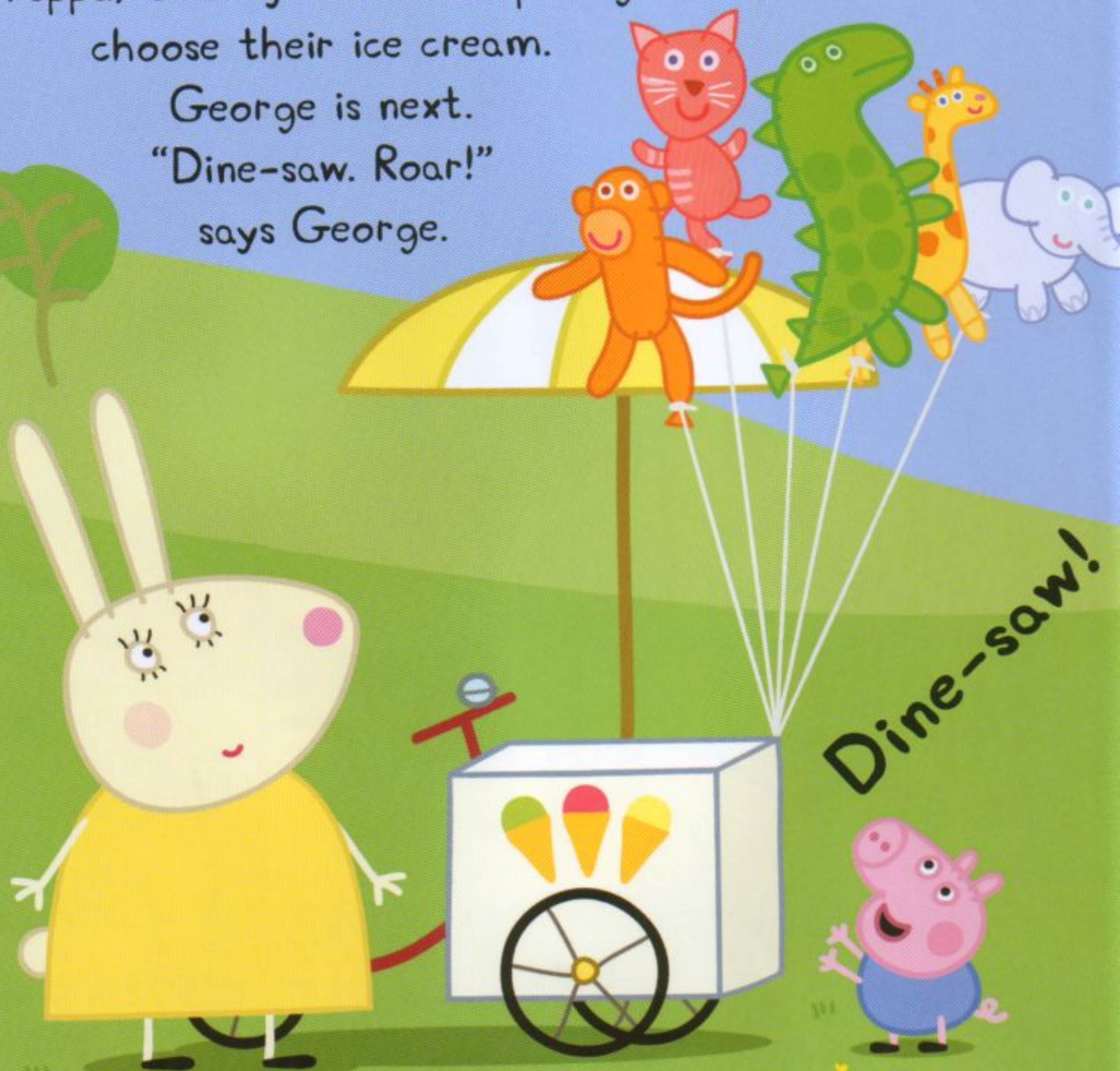
"Why not?" says Grandpa Pig.

"I think George wants a dinosaur balloon," says Miss Rabbit.

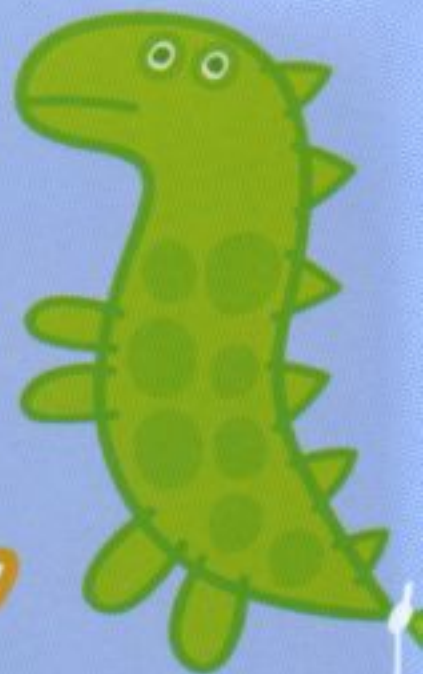
"Alright, how much is it?" Grandpa Pig says.

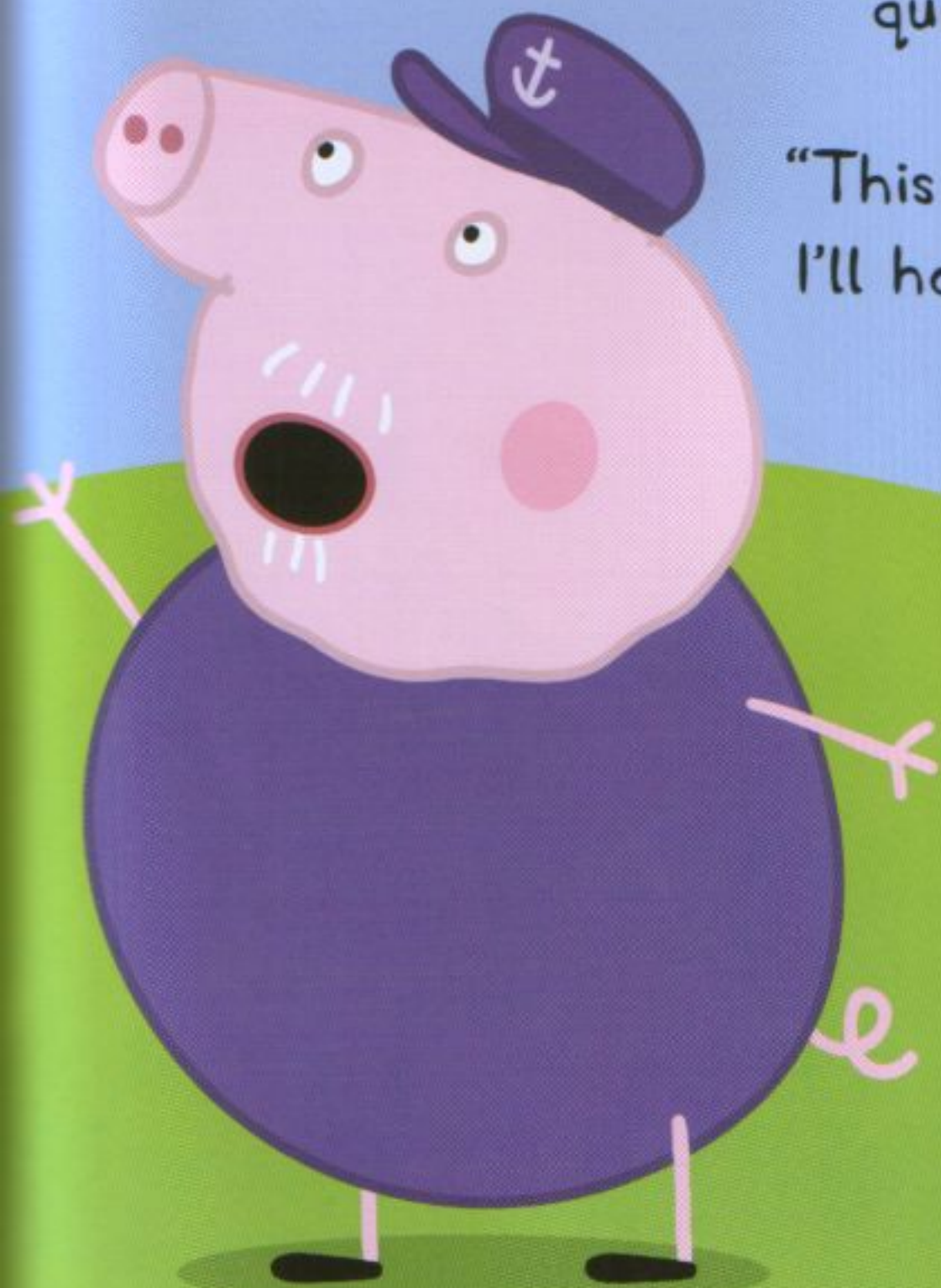
“Hold on tight to it,”

love the balloon.



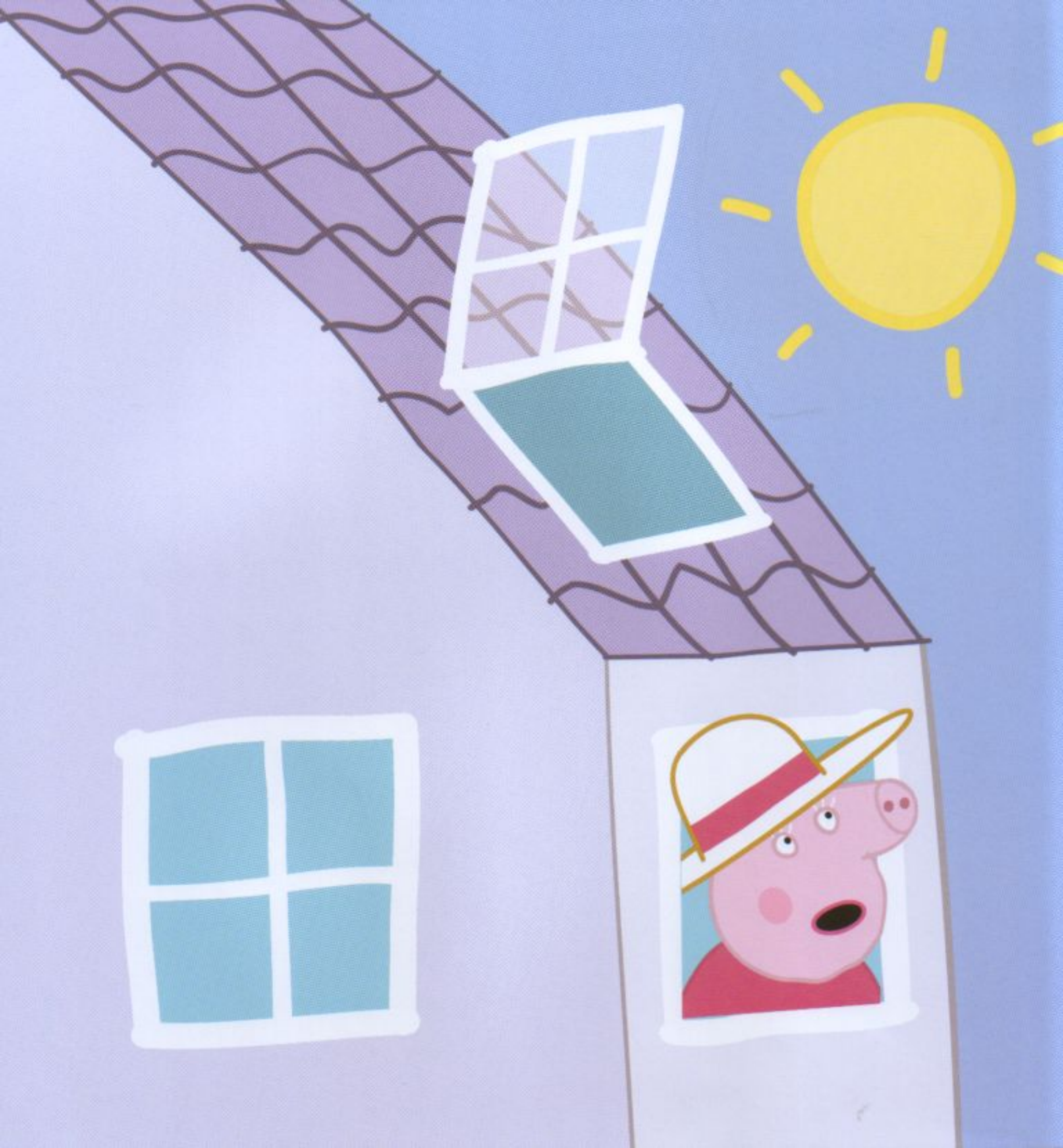




"Oh no!" George cries,

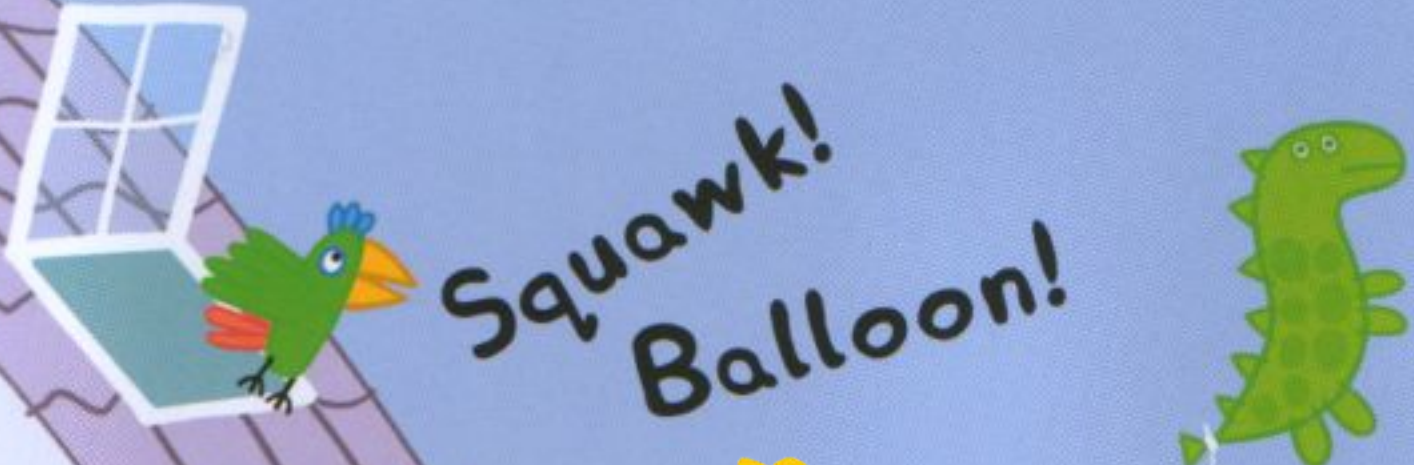
But the window is

Daddy Pig has an idea.

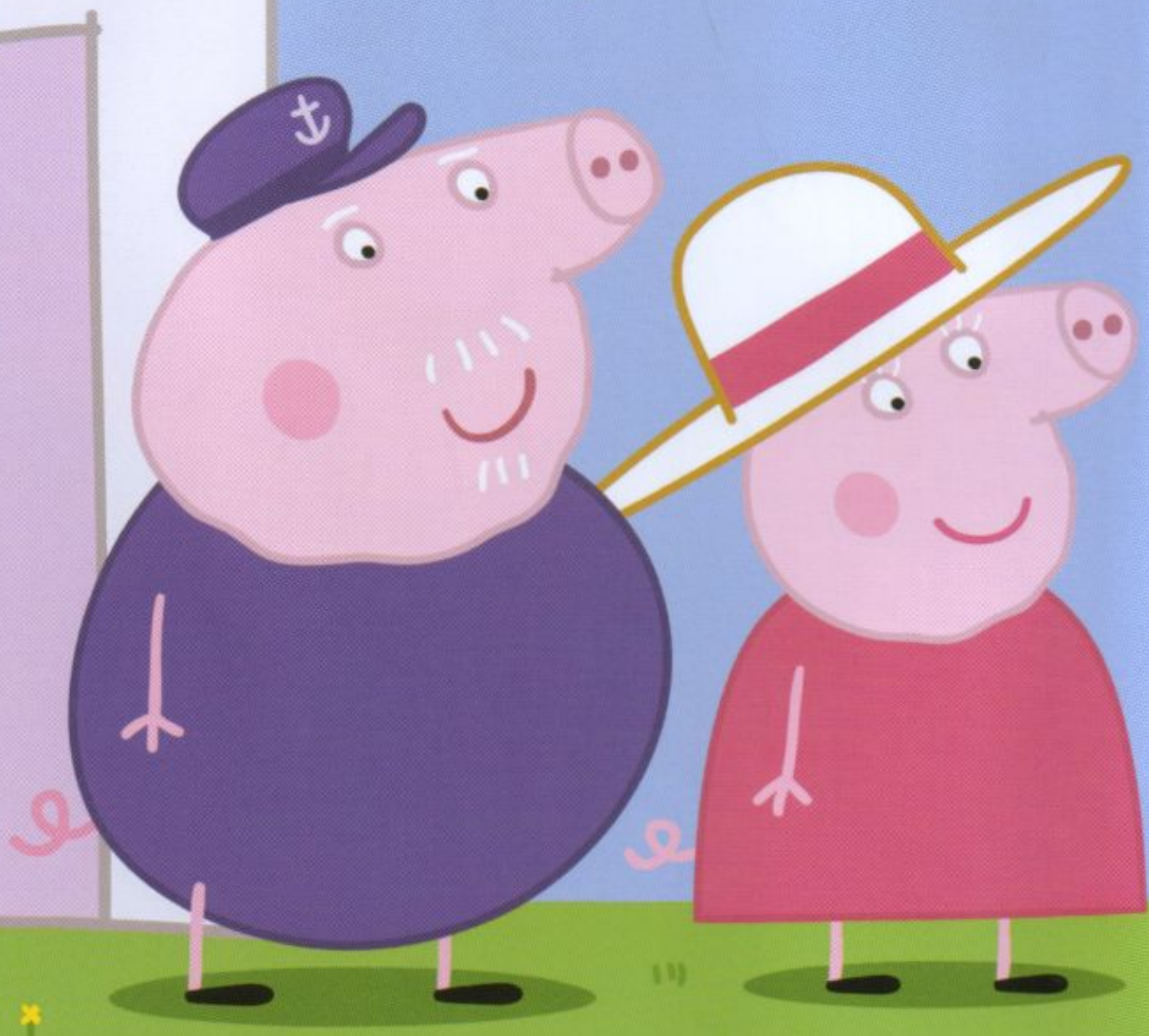
"I'll tie the balloon to your wrist, George," he says.
