


It's almost Christmas,

"What are you asking for?" asks Peppa.








The next day.

says Daddy Pig.






The tree is very big.


Daddy Pig's car is quite small.

Daddy Pig needs a rest!




It's time to decorate! Mummy Pig puts the lights on first.

Then Daddy Pig reaches way up high to put a star on the top.




The tree is beautiful!

"why does Santa come down the chimney?


Why doesn't he just use the front door?"

But Santa won't come unless you're asleep,


so up to bed you go!"





Soon Peppa is fast asleep too.






"Ho, ho-uh-oh!

"I can help!" says Peppa.






Danny wants a toy spaceship,







Emily a toy mouse.


A Scooter, please, for Suzy.



Rebecca would like a trumpet.








Zoe asked for a ball-and-paddle toy.
